## Timeline

- September 16:** MAAPP Dashboard goes live  
Counselors receive email with username and link to set password.
- October 1:** 2020-2021 FAFSA and MAAPP open

## Features

- Multiple Users:** Students, Student Representatives, District and High School Counselors, Institutional Financial Aid Directors and Administrators, Superintendents and Headmasters
- Dashboard:** Customized to user role

- Application:** Similar to previous application  
Progress bar  
Fewer questions per screen and better mobile optimization

## Updates

- Missing Documents:** Documents missing from counselors and students separated in student dashboard until April 1  
No "Missing Document" emails for documents missing from counselors until February 1
- High School Grade Files:** 7-semester GPA  
Submit files January or February  
Update individuals if changes are needed
- HELP Curriculum:** Certification needed by students. Required by law.  
Submit for All graduating students  
Certify completion of the HELP curriculum  
HELP Curriculum = IHL Required CPC + 1 Advanced Elective  
HELP Curriculum for 2022 = IHL Required CPC
