

WHO WE ARE

Our vision is that every child has access to a quality education. Since 2000, ACE has provided more than 66,000 scholarships to children from low-income families totaling nearly \$170 million and established partnerships with almost 900 private schools across the country. ACE Scholarships will be launching in Mississippi for the 2023-2024 school year with the hope of awarding approximately \$1 million in scholarships.

WHAT WE DO

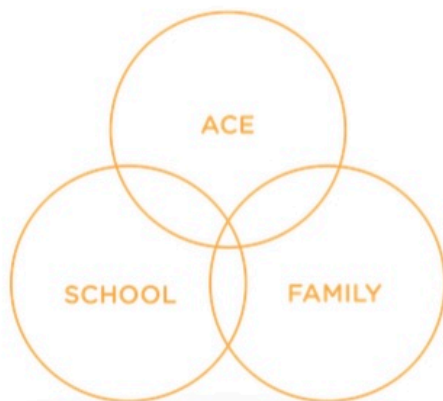
ACE offers partial tuition scholarships to students from low-income families so they may attend the private school of their choice. The ACE scholarship follows the child throughout their K-12 education.

Does my child qualify for a scholarship?

ACE scholarships are based solely on family income. See the chart for ACE Scholarships' financial eligibility.

Who pays what?

An ACE scholarship will pay up to 50% of private school tuition, or a maximum of \$3,000 per year for grades K-8 and \$4,000 per year for high school. The family is responsible for working out a payment plan with the school for the remainder of the tuition.
